Note: other re-entry programs may be acceptable if they meet the criteria found in the ***Administrative Rules – Part 5 - Section 5.4***

The re-entry program shall:

- have a written purpose, program and unit objectives and identified outcomes;
- conduct a program of a minimum of 120 hours of theory and 120 hours of clinical practice for the RN candidate, a minimum of 80 hours of theory and 80 hours of clinical practice for the LPN candidate;
- provide direct RN supervision for re-entry program clinical practice;
- be located within or, if individually designed, under the direction of, a nursing education program or an institutional nursing service education department.
