STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

STIPULATION

NOW COMES the State of Vermont, through State Prosecuting Attorney, Robert H. Backus, and Applicant, Tonya Bailey, who agree that the following facts are true and that based on these facts the Board may enter the order below conditioning Applicant's license.

FACTS

1. Applicant Bailey has been convicted of three crimes; Possession of Stolen Property (felony), on April 27, 2001; Simple Assault (misdemeanor), on December 19, 2003; and Disorderly Conduct (misdemeanor), on September 21, 2005.
2. She was satisfactorily discharged from probation on the first two charges on February 14, 2005 and paid a hundred dollar fine on the third charge.

UNDERSTANDINGS

3. The parties understand that the terms of this Stipulation and Consent Order are contingent upon review and acceptance by the Board and that if the Board rejects any portion the entire Stipulation and Consent Order shall be null and void.
4. The Applicant has read and reviewed this document fully and agrees that it contains the entire agreement between the parties.
5. This Stipulation and Consent Order is entered into voluntarily by the Applicant after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel. The Applicant has not been coerced by anyone into signing this Stipulation and Consent Order.
6. The Applicant is voluntarily waiving her right to a contested hearing before the Board.

CONSENT ORDER

- A. Based on the above stipulation and findings of this Board, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- i) Upon compliance with all other requirements of licensure Applicant shall be granted a conditioned license.
- ii) Applicant's license shall be conditioned for two years.
- iii) At the end of two years Applicant may petition to have the conditions removed from her license.
- iv) Applicant shall report to the Board within ten days if she is charged with any crime in any jurisdiction.
- v) Applicant shall not be convicted of a crime in any jurisdiction.
- vi) Applicant shall report to the Board within ten days any conviction of a crime in any jurisdiction.

B. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. §129(a).

C. This Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of the Applicant's licensing file and may be used for purposes of determining sanctions in any future disciplinary matter.
